Q: What are the Plumbing Board expiration dates for completing PLUMBING CONTINUING EDUCATION?

Any license or endorsement holder who lives in a county having no city with a population in excess of 100,000, or resides out of state, or who submits written proof to the Board from a physician stating the medical reason that the licensee is unable to attend a CPE class, may fulfill the current year CPE requirements by completing a correspondence course approved by the Board. All others must fulfill the current year CPE requirements by completing a classroom course.

2011-2012 Continuing Professional Education courses begin July 1, 2011 and end June 30, 2012. Class size is limited to 45 students, therefore, please allow adequate time for scheduling. *NOTE: Licenses that expire between September 30, 2011 and August 31, 2012 should not take continuing education AFTER June 30, 2012. To assure that you take the correct course for your renewal, or for any other questions regarding your plumbing license, contact the Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners at 800-845-6584.
